About prof. Ron Ofri:

Ron Ofri was a member of the charter class of the Koret School of Veterinary Medicine, Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Israel, where he is currently an Associate Professor in veterinary ophthalmology. He has published more than 75 refereed papers. Ron is also a very popular international speaker, having been invited to talk in more than 30 countries and 6 continents, lecturing in continuing education seminars, national meetings and world congresses for general practitioners, including BSAVA, SEVC, WSAVA and NAVC. Ron is a contributing author to the Gelatt's classic textbook *Veterinary Ophthalmology* (3rd, 4th and 5th editions) as well as a co-author of the popular textbook *Slatter's Fundamentals of Veterinary Ophthalmology* (4th and 5th editions). Ron is a Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Ophthalmology (ECVO), a former ECVO Executive Board member and in 2002-2005 he served as President of the *European Society of Veterinary Ophthalmology*.
