In 2010, he set up the ophthalmology department of the Aquivet referral hospital in Bordeaux and in 2011, he became recognised French specialist in veterinary ophthalmology. Dr Frédéric Goulle is member of the board of SFEROV (French Society of Veterinary Ophthalmological Studies and Research) and is also member of REOVVA (European network for veterinary ophthalmology and animal vision). He has a particular interest in corneal surgery, cataract and laser surgery.

Eduardo Huguet Baudin, DVM is Director of Oftalmovet, veterinary ophthalmology referral center, in Valencia, Spain). He obtained his certificate in veterinary ophthalmology at ENV Toulouse (France) in 2001, and became Diplomate of CLOVE in 2012.

He is founder of REOVVA (European Net for Veterinary Ophthalmology and Animal Vision) of Oftálmica working group, and SEOVET (Spanish Veterinary Ophthalmology Society), and professor of the Diploma de Oftalmología Veterinaria de la Universidad Complutense de Madrid, and of Corneal Workshop of the SFEROV at l'Ecole Vétérinaire de Toulouse.

His special interest are ocular surface, cataract surgery, gonioscopy, ultrasound in ophthalmology, and communication of knowledge to other ophthalmologist and general practitioners.
